



VALLEY MODERN QUILT GUILD

Round Robin 2018

Our ROUND ROBIN will start with a finished center block and complete 6 rounds.

These guidelines are just that...a guide. Please use 100% quilt-shop-quality cotton fabric. If you are a pre-washer, please include that information on your preference sheet. TREAT EACH ROUND AS IF IT WERE YOUR OWN QUILT.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Prepare a non-transparent box or bag for the project to travel through the rotations. Inside the box, please Include:

- Your name, phone number, and email address inside.
- Place the center quilt block and any other fabrics you would like used in the quilt. Enough fabric is very important. A rough guideline is at least a half yard per round, so 3 yards assorted fabrics is a bare minimum.
- A small journal or preference sheet, stating any strong likes or dislikes you would like other quilters to note.
- Quilt label for quilters to sign

REMEMBER: We will be using all the fabrics you have included to design and sew borders, so the more fabric selection, the more choices and design option. Please provide enough additional fabric to ensure it lasts through to the last border. Put the size and shape you would like your quilt to be in your journal or preference sheet. THESE ARE GUIDELINES, NOT GUARANTEES!

RULES

1. Each month you will be getting your ROUND from person A, and giving to person B...the same quilters every month. The HAND OFF sequence will be drawn randomly at the March meeting.
2. If something does happen and you can't finish your round or make it to the monthly meeting, it is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to finish and get your round passed on to the next quilter.
3. This is the MAIN RULE...If you don't finish your round and return it in time, your own quilt will be returned to you and you will not participate further.
4. NO PHOTOS PLEASE! In-process photos can be shared after the reveal. If you are in doubt about a color choice, you can contact the owner, but don't share the process.
5. Bring your ROUND ROBIN BOX to every Valley MQG Meeting:
Start date: March 26 • **1st Rotation:** April 30 • **2nd Rotation:** May 29 • **3rd Rotation:** June 25 • **4th Rotation:** July 30 • **5th Rotation:** August 27 • **REVEAL: September 24**

BASICS

Remember, you are working on someone else's quilt, so be sure to use your VERY BEST WORKMANSHIP. Sometimes, you might bite off more than you can chew...but, don't worry. If you add a round and it doesn't lay flat, or looks bad, take it off and do something less complex that might look better. Also, there are many quilters in our guild who would be happy to help with advice on a tricky bit of stitchery...give them a call. Another option would be to search for ROUND ROBIN QUILTS, or MEDALLION QUILTS on google.com or Pinterest. PLEASE DO NOT ALTER any work that has been done in previous rounds...only work on your round.

Add a 2-5 inch border, on each round, using fabric supplied with the center block, or add fabrics from your own stash, depending on the owner's journal or preference sheet. Turn it on point and add setting triangles, add borders to two sides, or just the top...the only limit is your imagination. Just be mindful and follow the modern quilt aesthetic. If you do decide to use fabrics from your own stash, send some along with the quilt to the next person...this saves a lot of running to shops to find more. REMEMBER TO BRING THE BOX TO EACH MEETING.
