A TEMPLATE FREE IMPROV MODERN BLOCK

AN EASY WAY TO TRY THIS MODERN TECHNIQUE

1. From your first solid color, cut fabric 8 1/2 inches square.
2. From the second color, lay a 2 1/2 inch strip on one side of the block. Sew scant 1/4 inch seam, making a triangular piece of the second color.
3. If you'd like a measurement, make the slice about 2 1/2 inches wide at one end and at least 9 inches long.
4. You may also add a curved improv piece, by placing both fabrics face up and cutting a SLIGHT curve thru both pieces. Ease the curved piece onto the 8 1/2 inch block.
