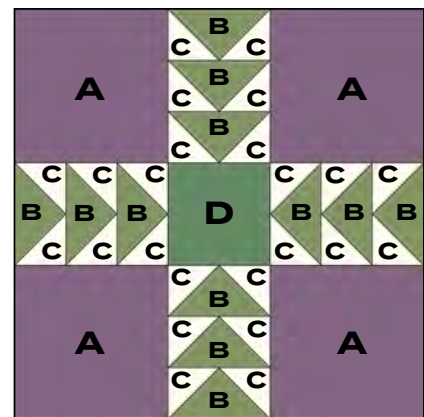
CROSSROADS

I love flying geese. They are a wonderfully versatile unit that can be found in all styles of quilting.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

(For fabric choices refer to the diagram)

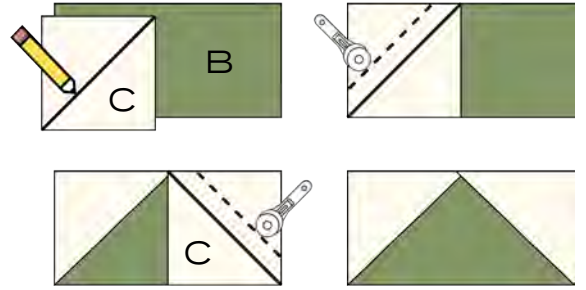


	4" Block	6" Block	8" Block	12" Block
A:	(4) 2" squares	(4) 2 3/4" squares	(4) 3 1/2" squares	(4) 5" squares
B:	(12) 1 1/2" x 1" rectangles	(12) 2" x 1 1/4" rectangles	(12) 2 1/2" x 1 1/2" rectangles	(12) 3 1/2" x 2" rectangles
C:	(24) 1" squares; draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each square.	(24) 1 1/4" squares; draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each square.	(24) 1 1/2" squares; draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each square.	(24) 2" squares; draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each square.
D:	(1) 1 1/2" square	(1) 2" square	(1) 2 1/2" square	(1) 3 1/2" square



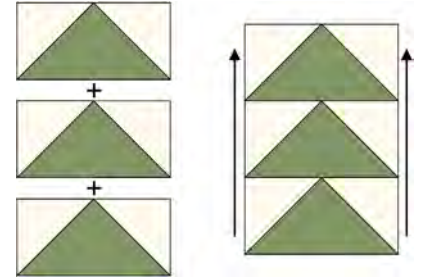
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

- Place (1) C square with a drawn diagonal line onto the corner of (1) B rectangle, right sides together and edges aligned. Diagrams show accurate C square orientation.
- Sew along the drawn diagonal line.
- Trim outermost excess fabric to 1/4". Press toward the corner.
- Repeat stitch and flip techniques on the remaining corner of the B rectangle as shown to complete a flying geese unit.

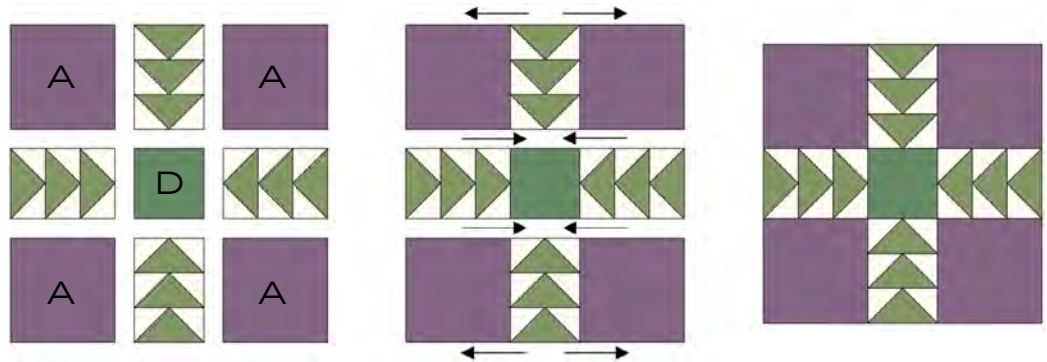


- Repeat to create (12) identical flying geese units.
- Trim flying geese units using the following guide:

- 4" Block: 1" x 1 1/2" unfinished (1/2" x 1" finished)
- 6" Block: 1 1/4" x 2" unfinished (3/4" x 1 1/2" finished)
- 8" Block: 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" unfinished (1" x 2" finished)
- 12" Block: 2" x 3 1/2" unfinished (1 1/2" x 3" finished)



- Complete block assembly using (12) flying geese units, (4) A squares and (1) D square. Arrows indicate pressing instructions.




- Trim block using the guide listed below:
 - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished (4" x 4" finished)
 - 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" unfinished (6" x 6" finished)
 - 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" unfinished (8" x 8" finished)
 - 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished (12" x 12" finished)

DESIGNER INFO

Tips: I suggest starching fabrics before cutting, for accuracy and for pressing nice sharp points and crisp seams.
